History

The Amish often host fund-raisers to help families pay for unexpected hospital bills or other needs. The Haystack Meal originated for this type of event because families could donate vegetables grown in their gardens and beef raised on their farms without having to purchase many ingredients. The goal is to create a haystack shape by layering the ingredients into a hearty blend of flavors and textures.

Menu

Create your own Haystack by layering cracker crumbs, rice, seasoned ground beef, lettuce, celery, mild sauce, onions, tomatoes, lettuce, green peppers and nacho chips and top it all off with our delicious cheese sauce. Wash it all down with a refreshing beverage!

To complete your meal, add a slice of freshly baked hearth bread and spread on scrumptious Amish Church Peanut Butter. Enjoy Ruthie's delectable apple cake for dessert.
