American classic comes to life on stage. (1st - 8th)

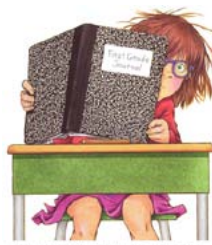


Annie Get Your Gun

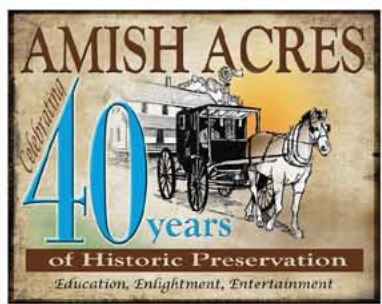
